- 15.09.1999** - Google moves its headquarters to Mountain View, California.
- 1.01.2000** - Google begins selling text-based advertisements with AdWords.
- 19.08.2004** - Google goes public with its initial public offering (IPO).
- 13.11.2006** - Google acquires YouTube, the popular video-sharing platform.
- 23.09.2008** - Google launches the Android operating system for mobile devices.
- 4.04.2011** - Larry Page becomes CEO of Google, replacing Eric Schmidt.

- 24.04.2012** - Google introduces Google Drive, a cloud storage service.
- 2.10.2015** - Google restructures and becomes a subsidiary of Alphabet Inc., a new holding company.
- 4.10.2016** - Google launches its virtual assistant, Google Assistant.
- 20.10.2017** - Google releases the Pixel smartphone, showcasing its hardware capabilities.
- 3.12.2019** - Sundar Pichai becomes CEO of both Google and Alphabet Inc.
- 14.01.2020** - Google announces plans to phase out third-party cookies in Chrome.
- 27.09.2021** - Google celebrates its 23rd anniversary and continues to expand its products and services.
